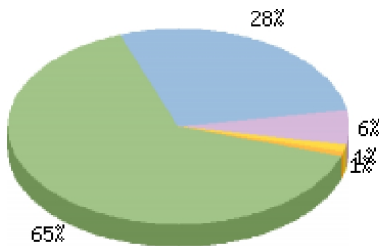
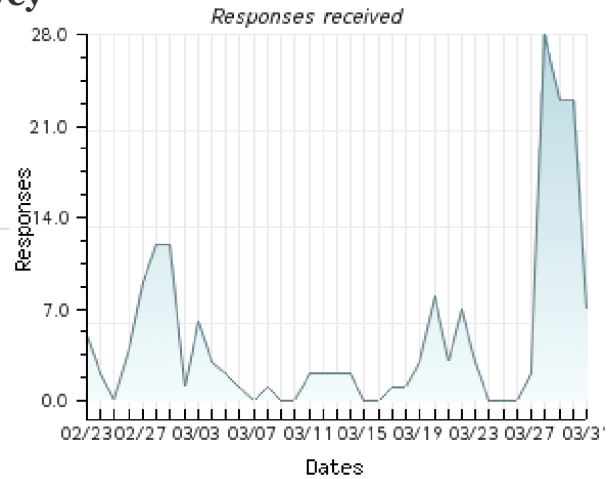

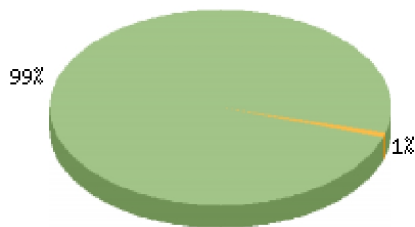
1. Age profile of the people who took survey

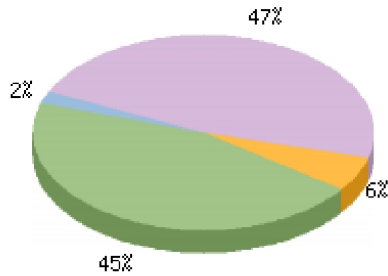






2. Gender details of the people who took survey



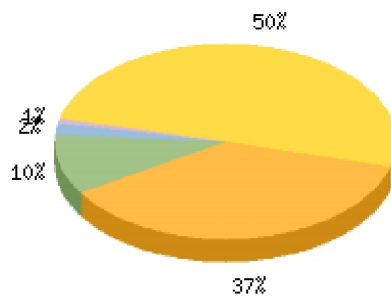

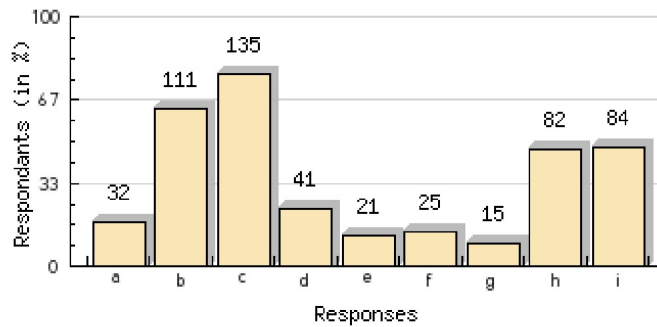

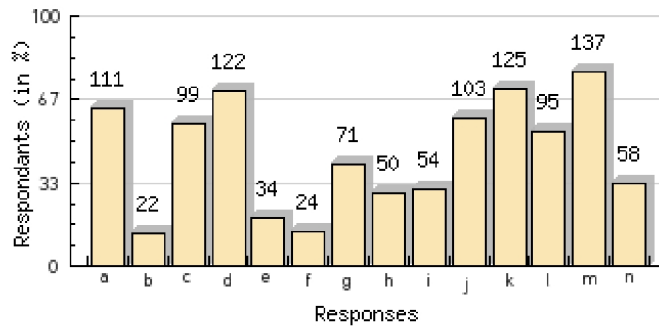

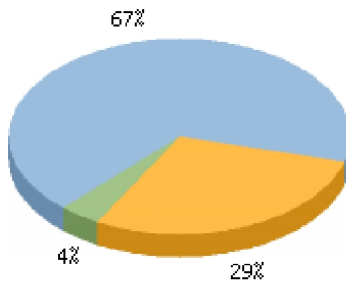

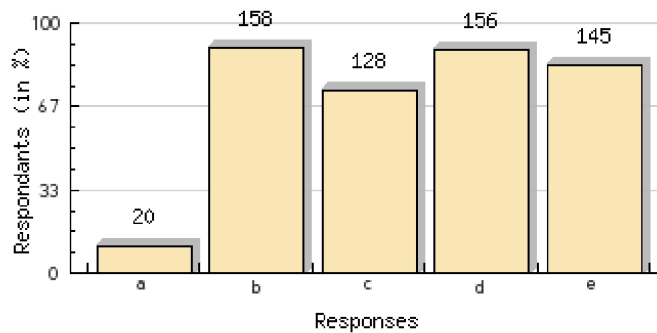

7. Do you think that the order (interim or final) passed against you was discriminatory & against your basic constitutional rights & natural justice?



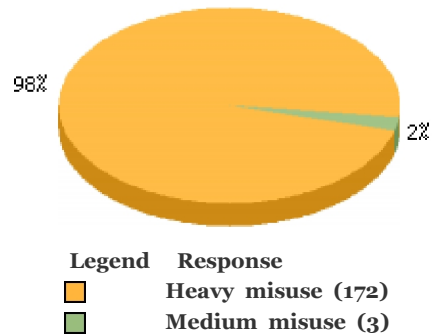

8. Please give your suggestions for the improvement of the DV Act.?

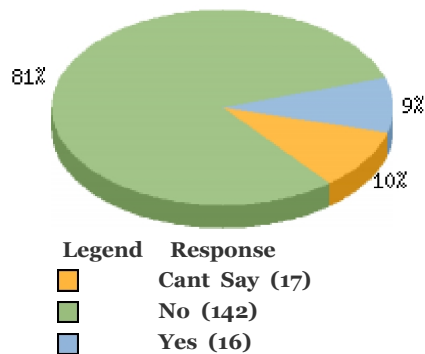

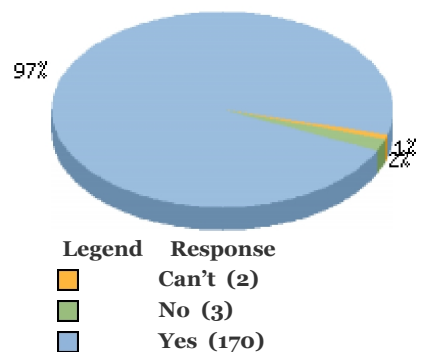

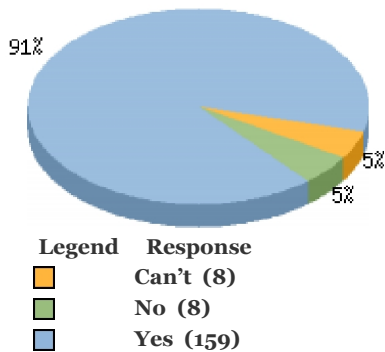
10. Whether this act is needed when already 498(A), CrPC 125 HMA and other reliefs are available?
